Page 3 1 HEARING OFFICER BRANCARD: All right. I'm 2 on Item 34 on our worksheet today. This is 3 Case 22766, Centennial Resource Production. MS. VANCE: Good morning, Mr. Examiner, 4 5 Paula Vance. I'm not sure I'm hearing --6 HEARING OFFICER BRANCARD: You have got a 7 soundtrack on with you. 8 MS. VANCE: I am not sure where that's coming from. Hold on a second. I'm sorry about 9 10 that. I literally have no idea where that's coming 11 from. 12 MR. FELDEVERT: I'm calling you. 13 TECHNICAL HEARING OFFICER GARCIA: Sounds 14 like somebody on hold. MS. VANCE: Yeah, that's not me. I'm not 15 sure if maybe somebody has unmuted themselves. 16 17 HEARING OFFICER BRANCARD: Mr. Feldewert, 18 are you pulling a prank on Ms. Vance? 19 MR. FELDEVERT: No, sir. I'm just 20 perplexed as she is. 21 MS. VANCE: It sounds like it went away. 22 HEARING OFFICER BRANCARD: It went away. 23 Thank you, Ms. Vance. 24 I have an entry of appearance from MRC 25 Permian Company.

Page 4 1 MR. BRUCE: Mr. Examiner, Jim Bruce for 2 MRC. 3 HEARING OFFICER BRANCARD: All right. 4 Does MRC object to this case going forward by affidavit? 5 No, sir. 6 MR. BRUCE: 7 HEARING OFFICER BRANCARD: Are there any 8 other entries of appearance for Case 22766? 9 Hearing none, Ms. Vance, you may proceed. 10 MS. VANCE: All right. I am going to try 11 that one more time. So this is Paula Vance with the Santa Fe office of Holland & Hart on behalf of the 12 13 Applicant, Centennial Resource Production, LLC. 14 In Case 22766 Centennial seeks to pool uncommitted mineral interests within the Bone Spring 15 formation, and the pool code is 96585, and that's 16 underlying a standard 320-acre horizontal spacing 17 unit comprised of the west half, west half of 18 19 Sections 12 and 1, Township 29 South, Range 35 East, 20 Lea County, New Mexico. 21 And Centennial seeks to dedicate the 22 spacing unit to the proposed King Eider, 12 Fed Com 501H well. 23 24 In this case we have provided the 25 compulsory pooling checklist, as well as a

self-affirmed statement and testimony of landman 1 Gavin Smith and geologist Isabel Harper, both of 2 3 whom have previously testified before the Division and their credentials have been accepted as a matter 4 of record. 5 Mr. Smith's affidavit is Exhibit C, which 6 7 includes sub-exhibits C1, which is a C102; C2, the 8 land tract map; C3, uncommitted owners; C4, the 9 sample well proposals letter with AFEs; and C5, a 10 chronology of contacts. 11 In this case, Mr. Smith testifies that the drilling of this well is in the best interest of 12 13 conservation, the prevention of waste, and the protection of correlative rights. 14

This is followed by Ms. Harper's 15 affidavit, which is Exhibit D, and I did want to 16 note that we were going to file a revised Exhibit D 17 this morning. Ms. Harper provided a small update 18 19 tweaked in Paragraph 16 of her affidavit, and it 20 states, "The structure match shows that the Bone 21 Spring dips gently to northwest rather than just the 22 west."

This also includes sub-exhibits D1, the locater map; D2, the Bone Spring sub-C structure map; D3, the Bone Spring cross section map; and D4,

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Page 6 the Bone Spring stratigraphic cross section. 1 2 In this case Ms. Harper did not observe 3 any faulting, pinch-outs or other geological impediments to the horizontal drilling of this well. 4 And lastly our Exhibit E, the affidavit of 5 6 notice with sample letters that were timely mailed 7 on April 15th, 2022 and May 13, 2022. 8 And the in May 13th was to notice 9 additional parties that were identified. And I'm 10 sorry, and Exhibit F, which is the affidavit of 11 notice of publication, which was timely published on April 17, 2022 and May 17th, 2022 to notice those 12 13 additional parties that were identified. 14 And unless there are any questions, I would ask that all exhibits and sub-exhibits be 15 admitted into the record and that Case 22766 be 16 taken under advisement by the Division at this time. 17 I stand by for any questions you might 18 19 have. 20 HEARING OFFICER BRANCARD: Thank you. 21 Mr. Bruce, any questions? 2.2 MR. BRUCE: No, sir. 23 HEARING OFFICER BRANCARD: Mr. Garcia? 24 TECHNICAL HEARING OFFICER GARCIA: No 25 questions.

Page 7 1 HEARING OFFICER BRANCARD: Ms. Vance, 2 let's go to the notice section. 3 MS. VANCE: Okay. HEARING OFFICER BRANCARD: It looks like 4 5 Mr. Rankin did the notice, so you can just blame 6 him. I'm looking at the mail postal delivery 7 report. 8 MS. VANCE: And I highlighted for you all 9 the parties that were to be noticed per the C2 10 Exhibit. 11 HEARING OFFICER BRANCARD: Well, you just 12 answered my question, what's the highlighting. 13 MS. VANCE: Yes, yeah. They provided 14 additional notice and I just wanted to make it clear 15 who were the required parties to be noticed so that's what that is. 16 17 HEARING OFFICER BRANCARD: So the parties in yellow are the ones being pooled here? 18 19 MS. VANCE: Yes, Mr. Examiner. 20 HEARING OFFICER BRANCARD: And the other 21 parties and the other --22 MS. VANCE: It was just additional notice and the Applicant, Centennial, just being cautious 23 24 about ensuring they provided notice to the required 25 parties.

Page 8 1 HEARING OFFICER BRANCARD: Okay. Thank 2 you. So did you -- you mailed it twice to XTO 3 because it looks like the first mailing to XTO was 4 5 refused. Right there at the top. At the top, XTO. 6 MS. VANCE: I'm looking. I see XTO. 7 HEARING OFFICER BRANCARD: It says, "Refused." 8 MS. VANCE: And, yes, I'm sorry, I should 9 10 have highlighted that second one as well that was delivered, I think it's one, two --11 12 HEARING OFFICER BRANCARD: Yes, okay, 13 there is another one there for Spring --14 MS. VANCE: It's about 12 lines down, Mr. Examiner. 15 16 HEARING OFFICER BRANCARD: Okay. 17 MS. VANCE: Sorry I missed that for you. 18 HEARING OFFICER BRANCARD: Okay. Those 19 are my questions. 20 Mr. Garcia, did you have any other 21 questions? 2.2 TECHNICAL HEARING OFFICER GARCIA: No. 23 HEARING OFFICER BRANCARD: All right. 24 With that, the exhibits in Case 22766 will 25 be admitted into the record and Case 22766 will be
