Platinum Exploration, Inc. has filed an application with the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division seeking an order abolishing the special rules for the South Knowles-Devonian Pool, and instituting statewide well spacing and location regulations for the pool. The pool rules currently provide for 80-acre spacing, and wells to be within 150 feet of the center of a quarter-quarter section. The pool covers all or parts of Sections 12, 13, and 24, Township 17 South, Range 38 East, N.M.P.M.; and Sections 7, 18, and 19, Township-17 South, Range 39 East, N.M.P.M. The hearing is scheduled for Thursday, March 17, 2005 at the Division's office at 1220 South St. Francis Drive, Santa Fe, NM 87505. As an interest owner, you have the right to appear at the hearing. Failure to appear will preclude you from contesting the matter at a later date. The pool is centered approximately 2 miles east-northeast of Knowles, New Mexico.
