

This is the well you & I talked about yesterday on the phone.

It appears that this well started injection in 1982 as per the attached WFX-498 although I still can't find the order on the State web site. The well was an active injection well until 1996 when a previous operator applied to convert it to a producer. The conversion to producer was never done, and the well has remained shut-in (injection) since that time. The current injection permit may have expired. Lime Rock would like to resume previously permitted injection operations.

Do we still have to go through a full C-108 application???
