Mexico Oil Conservation Division, JAMI BAILEY,
Chairwoman, and SCOTT A. DAWSON, Commissioner of
Public Lands, and ROBERT S. BALCH, Designee of the
Secretary of Energy and Minerals, on Friday, July
29, 2011, in Porter Hall, Santa Fe, New Mexico.

1 MADAM CHAIRWOMAN BAILEY: Today is Friday,
2 July 29, a continuation of the meeting of the Oil
3 Conservation Commission.

4 We have all three commissioners in
5 attendance this morning. I am Jami Bailey, Chairman
6 of the commission. We also have Commissioner Bob
7 Balch and Commissioner Scott Dawson.

8 We have completed testimony for case --
9 combined cases, Consolidated Cases 14558 and Case
10 14577, and the commission is about to go into
11 executive session.

12 Do I hear a motion for the commission to
13 go into executive session for the sole purpose of
14 deliberating in the consolidated cases?

15 MR. BALCH: I'll make that motion.

16 MR. DAWSON: I'll second.

17 MADAM CHAIRWOMAN BAILEY: All those in
18 favor?

19 MR. BALCH: Aye.

20 MR. DAWSON: Aye.

21 MADAM CHAIRWOMAN BAILEY: Aye.

22 All those opposed?

23 Motion passes, three-zero.

24 (A recess was taken from 9:00 a.m. to
25 10:12 a.m.)

1 MADAM CHAIRWOMAN BAILEY: We'll go back on
2 the record.

3 Do you have a motion to go back into
4 session.

5 MR. DAWSON: Yes.

6 MADAM CHAIRWOMAN BAILEY: Is there a
7 second?

8 MR. BALCH: I will second.

9 MADAM CHAIRWOMAN BAILEY: All those in
10 favor?

11 MR. BALCH: Aye.

12 MR. DAWSON: Aye.

13 MADAM CHAIRWOMAN BAILEY: Aye.

14 The commission had gone into executive
15 session in accordance with New Mexico Statute
16 10-15-1 and the commission resolution on open
17 meetings.

18 The only topic for discussion were the
19 consolidated cases 14558 and 14577.

20 The commission finds in favor of COG for
21 vertical expansion of the Burch Keely Unit in Eddy
22 County and for vertical expansion of the Grayburg
23 Jackson, Seven Rivers, Queen, Grayburg San Andres
24 pool, to correspond with the unitized formation of
25 the Burch Keely Unit in Eddy County.

1 The evidence presented to the commission
2 supports this approval. And this evidence includes,
3 but is not limited to, the facts that the expansion
4 of the unit is supported by the unit agreement; that
5 in and of itself, approval of the expansion of the
6 unit and the pool will not result in waste or
7 interference of correlative rights.

8 This decision will also deny the motion to
9 stay.

10 We ask for proposed findings and
11 conclusions from the attorneys, both parties, by
12 August 26, so that we are able to sign this order at
13 our regularly-scheduled commission hearing on
14 September 22nd.

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
