



CASE 14731: Application of EOG Resources, Inc. for approval of additional horizontal wells in the Bone Spring formation within the Potash Area, Eddy County, New Mexico. Applicant seeks approval to drill its proposed Parkway 23 State Com Well Nos. 5H and 6H, and its proposed Parkway 23 State Well No. 7H, as additional horizontal wells in the Bone Spring formation within the Potash Area, underlying Section 23, Township 19 South, Range 29 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico. This area was the subject of Order No. R-13354 entered in Case No. 14584, which approved the Parkway 23 State Com Well Nos. 2H and 3H, and the Parkway 23 State Well No. 4H, as horizontal wells in the Bone Spring formation at similar surface locations. The proposed additional horizontal wells will likewise be drilled to an approximate depth of 8400 feet in the Turkey Track Bone Spring Pool. Said location is within the Potash Area and located approximately 17 miles northeast of Carlsbad, New Mexico.
