COG Operating, LLC ("Concho") requests a continuance of the above-referenced cases. Concho has filed several competing pooling applications which are set to be heard on the August 4, 2011 docket. Both Concho and Burnett are working interest owners in four sections in Township 17 South, Range 31 East and are competing for operations. Since the cases are related, all cases should be heard at the same time. Concho also believes that the cases will take a considerable amount of time to be heard. Therefore, as a matter of judicial efficiency and economy, Concho respectfully requests that both the Concho and Burnett cases be set for a special examiner hearing docket at a time that is mutually agreeable to all parties.
