





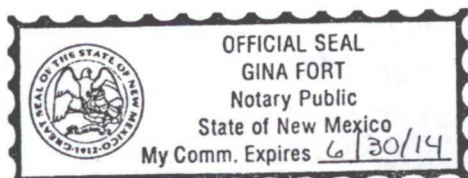

Case No. 14738: Application of EOG Resources, Inc. for Simultaneous Dedication and an exception to the Special Rules and Regulations for the Red Hills-Bone Spring Pool, Lea County, New Mexico

Applicant in the above-styled cause seeks an order allowing an exception to the special rules and regulations governing the Red Hills-Bone Spring Pool for a 480-acre project area comprised of the W/2 of Section 31, Township 24 South, Range 34 East and the NW/4 of Section 6, Township 25 South, Range 34 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico. Applicant seeks authority to drill and complete multiple horizontal wells at unorthodox locations in the Red Hills-Bone Spring Pool underlying this 480-acre project area provided that the producing interval for any such wells are located no closer than 330 feet from the outer boundary of the designated project area. Said area is located approximately 20 miles West of Jala, New Mexico.

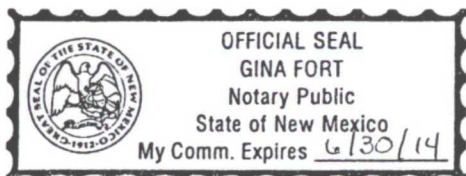
