### **APPLICATION**

MEWBOURNE ENERGY COMPANY ("Mewbourne") through its undersigned attorneys, hereby makes application to the Oil Conservation Division pursuant to the provisions of N.M. Stat. Ann. § 70-2-17, for an order: (1) creating a non-standard spacing unit comprised of the N/2 S/2 of Section 34, Township 18 South, Range 30 East, NMPM, which will be the Project Area for the Dorado "34" Federal Com Well No. 1H to be horizontally drilled from a surface location 1850 feet from the South line and 620 feet from the East line and then in a easterly direction in the Bone Spring formation to a bottom hole terminus at a location 1850 feet from the South line and 330 feet from the West line of said Section 34; and (2) pooling all mineral interests in the Bone Spring formation in this non-standard spacing and proration unit, and in support of its application states:

- 1. Mewbourne is a working interest owner in the N/2 S/2 of said Section 34 and has the right to drill thereon. Mewbourne has an interest in each of the 40-acre spacing units in this project area and therefore has standing to bring this pooling application.
- 2. Mewbourne proposes to dedicate the above-referenced spacing and proration unit to its Dorado "34" Federal Com Well No. 1H which it proposes to drill as an oil well from a standard surface location 1850 feet from the South line and 620 feet from the East line (Unit I) of said Section 34, and then in an easterly direction in the Bone Spring formation to a bottomhole

terminus at a point 1850 feet from the South line and 330 feet from the West line (Unit L) of said Section 34.

- 3. Mewbourne has sought and been unable to obtain a voluntary agreement for the development of these lands from certain interest owners in the subject spacing units who are identified on **Exhibit A** to this application.
- 4. Said pooling of interests will avoid the drilling of unnecessary wells, will prevent waste and will protect correlative rights.
- 5. In order to permit Mewbourne to obtain its just and fair share of the oil and gas underlying the subject lands, all mineral interests should be pooled, and Mewbourne Oil Company should be designated the operator of this non-standard spacing unit and the well to be drilled thereon.

WHEREFORE, Mewbourne Oil Company requests that this application be set for hearing before an Examiner of the Oil Conservation Division on October 27, 2011 and, after notice and hearing as required by law, the Division enter its order:

- A. creating a non-standard spacing and proration unit in the Bone Spring formation comprised of the N/2 S/2 of Section 34, Township 18 South, Range 30 East, NMPM;
- B. pooling all mineral interests in the subject spacing and proration units;
- C. designating Mewbourne Oil Company operator of this unit and the well to be drilled thereon;
- D. authorizing Mewbourne Oil Company to recover its costs of drilling, equipping and completing the well;
- E. approving the actual operating charges and costs of supervision while drilling and after completion, together with a provision adjusting the rates pursuant to the COPAS accounting procedures; and

F. imposing a penalty for the risk assumed by Mewbourne Oil Company in drilling and completing the well against any working interest owner who does not voluntarily participate in the drilling of the well.
