3 on that?

4 MS. MUNDS-DRY: Everyone is in agreement  
5 on that.

6 EXAMINER JONES: I expected more people  
7 here for that case.

8 MR. BROOKS: So continued to the 1st?

9 EXAMINER JONES: The 15th.

10 MR. BROOKS: I was hoping for the 1st,  
11 because the 15th is my docket.

12 MS. MUNDS-DRY: I expect that case to go  
13 away, so don't worry about that one.

14 MR. BROOKS: That would be good.

15 EXAMINER JONES: Any other changes? Okay.


