CASE 14055: (Re-opened)

Application of C & D Management Company to Re-Open Case No. 14055, etc., Eddy County, New Mexico.

Applicant is the operator of record of seventeen (17) wells located in Sections 12, 13, 14, 24, and 25 of Township 17 South, Range 27 East, N.M.P.M., and Section 18 of Township 17 South, Range 28 East, N.M.P.M., identified in Commission Order No. R-12913-E. Applicant requests that Case No. 14055 be re-opened to allow applicant to provide evidence of its compliance with Division reporting obligations and financial assurance requirements, and that the Division enter an order granting applicant further time to bring wells into compliance before they are plugged by the Division. Applicant also requests that any order entered re-instate applicant's authority to transport. The wells are located approximately 10 miles east-southeast of Artesia, New Mexico.

CASE 14575: (Re-opened)

Motion of Targa Midstream Services LLC to Reopen Case to Offer Proof of Completion and Results of Pressure

Testing. Applicant has filed a motion to reopen case no. 14575 and to hold a hearing to allow Applicant to, among other things, offer proof that it has completed the Eunice AGI Well and is operating the well in accordance with the requirements of Order No. R-12809-C, to present the results of pressure transient testing and other test results, to present evidence concerning the extent of plume propagation, and to present evidence concerning the time limit for injection. The Eunice AGI Well (API No. 30-025-21497) is located 2,580 feet from the south line and 1,200 feet from the west line of Section 27, Township 22 South, Range 37 East, NMPM (Unit L), Lea County, New Mexico.
