Application of Cimarex Energy Co. for compulsory pooling, Eddy County, New Mexico. Applicant seeks an order pooling all mineral interests from the surface to the base of the Glorieta-Yeso formation underlying the NW/4 SE/4 of Section 6, Township 19 South, Range 26 East, NMPM, to form a standard 40-acre oil spacing and proration unit for any and all formations or pools developed on 40-acre spacing within that vertical extent. The unit will be dedicated to the Colorado 6 Fee Well No. 1, to be drilled at an orthodox location. Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling and completing the well and the allocation of the cost thereof, as well as actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of applicant as operator of the well, and a 200% charge for the risk involved in drilling and completing the well. Applicant in the above-styled cause seeks an order: (1) creating a non-standard 160-acre spacing and proration unit comprised of the W/2 E/2 of Section 6, Township 19 South, Range 26 East, NMPM, (2) approving a non-standard location for its proposed horizontal well, and (3) pooling all mineral interests in the Glorieta-Yeso formation underlying this acreage. Said non-standard unit is to be dedicated to applicant's proposed Arabian "6" Fee Well No. 8H, to be horizontally drilled from a non-standard surface location 150 feet from the South line and 380 feet from the East line (Unit P) to a bottom hole location 330 feet from the North line and 380 feet from the East line (Unit A) of Section 6.
