Dear Ms. Bailey:

On January 23, 2012, the Oil Conservation Commission entered Order No. R-13372-D which, among other matters, granted the application of David H. Arrington Oil And Gas, Inc. for an order pooling the S/2 of Section 26, Township 15 South, Range 34 East, NMPM. Order Paragraph 5 provides that "Arrington shall re-enter and re-complete the well within 90 days of the entry of this order, and thereafter shall continue to re-establish production from the Morrow formation with due diligence."

The purpose of this letter is to advise the Commission that Arrington Oil & Gas, Inc. has re-entered and completed this well in the Morrow formation, is now producing gas and water from the Morrow formation and is continuing its efforts to re-establish commercial production from the well. Accordingly, Arrington can report that the conditions of Order Paragraph 5 have been met.
