

Dear Mr. Ezeanyim:

During the pre-hearing phone conference this afternoon with you, Mr. Tommy Robbins and Mr. Brooks, the Commission's attorney, Mr. Robbins agreed that if this case were continued to the April 7, 2005 docket then he would be available.

It appears that Mr. Robbins is the only interest owner that desires to appear in and be present at the hearing for this case. Although there appears to be no legal basis for Mr. Robbins' objection, I wish to inform you that Lance Oil & Gas Company, Inc., as an accommodation to Mr. Robbins, will agree to continuing this case to the April 7, 2005 docket with the understanding that it will be heard on that date and that no further continuances will be granted.

In addition, in order to remove any doubt that Lance has complied with Section 70-2-17.C of the New Mexico Oil & Gas Act, Lance will have one of its landmen, Mr. Paul Lehrman, contract Mr. Robbins in a further effort to obtain a voluntary agreement for this interest.
