STATEMENT OF THE CASE

Yates' application seeks approval of a non-standard 80-acre oil spacing and proration unit in the Salt Lake-Delaware pool, comprising the SE/4 NW/4 and NE/4 SW/4 of Section 14, Township 20 South, Range 32 East, NMPM in Lea County. The location is approximately thirty (30) miles west of Hobbs. The proposed non-standard oil spacing and proration unit will be dedicated to Yates' Belco "AIA" Federal No. 6 directional well.


PROPOSED EVIDENCE
