APPLICATION

Parallel Petroleum LLC, through its undersigned attorneys, hereby makes application for an order approving its High Hopes Exploratory Unit and in support of this application states:

1. The proposed Unit Area for the High Hopes Exploratory Unit consists of 12,482.52 acres, more or less, of Federal, State of New Mexico, and Fee Lands, situated in Eddy County, New Mexico. The horizontal limits of said unit are described as follows:

Township 18 South, Range 21 East, N.M.P.M.

Section 1:	W/2, E/2 NE/4, NE/4 NE/4 and NW/4 SE/4
Section 2 - 4:	All
Section 8-11:	All
Section 14-17:	All
Section 20-22:	All
Section 27-29:	All
Section 32-33:	All

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2. The Unit Agreement has been approved by a sufficient percentage of the interest owners within the proposed Unit Area to provide effective control of unit operations.

3. The Applicant, Parallel Petroleum LLC, is designated Unit Operator in said Unit Agreement and proposes the formation of the Unit to test all oil and gas in all formations under the unit area from the surface to the base of the Mississippi Lime formation or 7,500 feet, whichever is deeper.

4. The proposed Unit Area covers all of the formations and geological structures in the Unit Area.

5. Said Unit Agreement and the unitized operation and management of the Unit Area will be in the interest of conservation and the prevention of waste, and will protect the correlative rights of all parties concerned.

WHEREFORE, Parallel Petroleum LLC requests that this application be set for hearing before an Examiner of the Oil Conservation Division on June 25, 2012, that notice be given as required by law and the rules of the Division, and that the High Hopes Exploratory Unit be approved.
