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WHEREUPON, the following proceedings were had at 1 9:31 a.m.: 2 3 CHAIRMAN FESMIRE: The next cause before the 4 5 Commission is Case Number 13,351, the de novo Application of Edge Petroleum Exploration Company to restrict the 6 effect of the special rules and regulations for the Dos 7 Hermanos Gas Pool in Eddy County, New Mexico. 8 9 Again, Commissioner Brooks [sic], would you explain to the Commission where we are on this case? 10 MR. BROOKS: This case was heard at the 11 Commission's March meeting, and following the conclusion of 12 13 the testimony the Commission met in executive session and instructed me as to the decision that the Commission 14 15 believed was appropriate in that case, which was basically to enter an order granting the compulsory pooling as 16 17 requested by Edge Petroleum -- I'm sorry, not compulsory pooling, I misspoke -- granting the rule change as 18 19 requested by Edge Petroleum, which would remove the 20 peripheral area around the Dos Hermanos Pool from the operation of the pool rules, with one important exception, 21 and that was that the wells that might be drilled within 22 23 the peripheral area and completed in the Morrow zone would have to be located at least 1250 feet from the outer 24 25 boundary of the Dos Hermanos Pool. Otherwise, the spacing

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in that area would go back to the statewide rules. 1 And so that was not the position advocated by 2 either party but it was the position that the Commission 3 determined was appropriate. And I believe that is what the 4 order does, and the order has been presented for your 5 6 signature. 7 COMMISSIONER BAILEY: I believe you misspoke and said 1250 feet instead of 1650 feet. 8 9 MR. BROOKS: I am sorry, Commissioner, you are 10 correct. 1650 feet. I was fumbling around trying to find a copy of the order. There was not one in the briefing 11 book, and I didn't have one, so I spoke from memory, and 12 I'm sure that you are correct. 1650 feet from the outer 13 boundary of the Dos Hermanos Pool. 14 CHAIRMAN FESMIRE: Commissioner Bailey, that's my 15 recollection; is that yours? 16 17 COMMISSIONER BAILEY: Yes, it is. 18 CHAIRMAN FESMIRE: And have you had a chance to 19 review the proposed order? 20 COMMISSIONER BAILEY: Yes, I have, and I expect to sign it. 21 22 Okay, and I took have reviewed CHAIRMAN FESMIRE: 23 the proposed order and believe that it indicates the decision of the Commission and will sign it at this time. 24 Let the record reflect that the order in Case 25
