2 this morning. This is the Examiner Hearing for June the  
3 7th, 2012. I'm William V. Jones. I'll be the Presiding  
4 Examiner, and Honorable David Brooks will be here with me  
5 as an attorney and co-Examiner.

6 EXAMINER BROOKS: Formerly honorable.

22 continued to July the 12th.

23 Page 6, Case 14846 is continued to June 25th;  
24 Case 14847 is continued to June 25th; and Case 14852 is  
25 continued to June 25th.

1 Any other corrections or --

2 MR. BRUCE: Mr. Examiner, I think you  
3 missed one. Actually, on page 5, Case 19, the Chesapeake  
4 operating one. It's Mr. Rankin's case, but I did send  
5 him a letter continuing it to July 12th, I believe.

6 EXAMINER JONES: Okay. Case 14825 is  
7 continued to July the 12th.

8 Any other changes to the continuances and  
9 dismissals? Okay.


