STATEMENT OF THE CASE

APPLICANT

Division Order No. R-13350 (i) abolished the Seven Rivers-Yeso Pool and the Cemetery-Yeso Pool, and (ii) expanded the North Seven Rivers Glorieta-Yeso Pool to include the acreage in the abolished pools and additional acreage, so that it comprised the following lands:

Applicant requests that the special rules and regulations for the North Seven Rivers Glorieta-Yeso Pool be made permanent effective retroactive to January 18, 2012.
