Agave Energy Company's Amended Second Motion to Amend Order No. R-13507. Agave Energy Company has filed a motion requesting the Oil Conservation Commission to amend Order No. R-13507, which authorizes Agave Energy to dispose of treated acid gas (TAG) from its Red Hills Gas Processing Plan by injecting the TAG stream into Agave Energy's Red Hills AGI #1 well. The motion requests that the Commission: (1) eliminate the requirement in Order No. R-13507 that Agave Energy reenter and replug the plugged and abandoned Government L Com #2 well (API 30-025-26369) well, place a balanced plug in the injection zone and replug the well; (2) eliminate the requirement in the order that Agave Energy reenter and replug the plugged and abandoned Government L Com #001 (API 30-025-25604) well; and (3) reduce either the life span of Agave Energy's injection authority or the total amount of acid gas to be injected. The Red Hills AGI #1 well is located in Section 13, Township 24 South, Range 33 East, NMPM, in Lea County, approximately twenty (20) miles northwest of Jal, New Mexico.
