FINDS THAT:


(1) Order No. R-13649 contains a clerical error in the legal description of the Unit pooled thereby.

- (1) Ordering Paragraph (1) of Order No. R-13649, issued in Case No. 14886 on November 6, 2012, is hereby amended, *nunc pro tunc*, effective as of November 6, 2012, to read:
 - (1) A non-standard 160-acre oil spacing and proration unit (the Unit) is hereby established in the Bone Spring formation [undesignated Lusk-Bone Spring Pool (41440)], consisting of the N/2 N/2 of Section 6, Township 19 South, Range 32 East, NMPM, in Lea County, New Mexico.

- (2) In all other respects Order No. R-13649 shall remain in full force and effect as originally written.
