### Ladies and Gentlemen:

This letter is to advise you that Huntington Energy, L.L.C. has filed the enclosed amended application with the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division seeking an order pooling all mineral interests from the base of the Mesaverde formation to the Base of the Dakota formation in the following described acreage in Section 2, Township 25 North, Range 7 West, NMPM: the W/2 to form a standard 320-acre spacing and proration unit for all formations developed on a 320-acre spacing within that vertical extent which includes but is not necessarily limited to the Basin-Dakota Gas Pool; the NW/4 to form a standard spacing and proration unit for all formations developed on 160-acre spacing within that vertical extent; and the SW/4 NW/4 to form a standard spacing and proration unit for all formations developed on 40-acre spacing within that vertical extent. Said units are to be dedicated to its Canyon Largo Unit Well No. 473 to be drilled at a standard gas well location 1625 feet from the North line and 1285 feet from the West line of said Section 2. Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling and completing said well and the allocation of the cost thereof as well as actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of Huntington Energy, L.L.C. as operator of the well and a 200% charge for risk involved in drilling said well.

This amended application has been set for hearing before a Division Examiner on May 5. 2005. The hearing will be held in Porter Hall in the Oil Conservation Division's Santa Fe Offices located at 1220 South Saint Francis Drive, Santa Fe, New Mexico 87505. You are not required to attend this hearing, but as an owner of an interest that may be affected by this application, you may appear and present testimony. Failure to appear at that time and become a party of record will preclude you from challenging the matter at a later date.

Parties appearing in cases are required by Division Rule 1208.B to file a Pre-hearing Statement three days in advance of a scheduled hearing. This statement must be filed at the Division's Santa Fe office lat the above specified address and should include: the names of the parties and their attorneys; a concise statement of the case; the names of
