STATEMENT OF THE CASE

APPLICANT

JTD Resources, LLC seeks an order pooling all mineral interests from the surface to the base of the Abo formation underlying the NE/4NE/4 of Section 3, Township 20 South, Range 38 East, NMPM, to form a standard 40-acre oil spacing and proration unit for any and all formations or pools developed on 40-acre spacing within that vertical extent, including the Undesignated Nadine-San Andres Pool, Undesignated House-Blinebry Pool, Undesignated North House-Tubb Pool, Undesignated House (Drinkard) Pool, and Undesignated House-Abo Pool. The unit is to be dedicated to the Salem Well No. 1, to be located at an orthodox oil well location. Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling and completing the well and the allocation of the cost thereof, as well as actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of Capataz

Operating, Inc. as operator of the well, and a 200% charge for the risk involved in drilling and completing the well.


