APPLICATION

Edge Petroleum Exploration Company applies for an order approving a non-standard gas spacing and proration unit in the Morrow formation comprising the S½ of Section 28, Township 19 South, Range 32 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico, and in support thereof, states:

1. Applicant is a working interest owner in the S½ of Section 28, and has the right to drill a well thereon.
2. Applicant proposes to drill its South Lusk 28 "H" Fed. Com. Well No. 1, at an orthodox location in the SW¼SW¼ of Section 28, to a depth sufficient to test the Morrow formation.
3. Section 28 is within the Lusk-Morrow Gas Pool. Under Order No. R-2373, as amended, the Lusk-Morrow Gas Pool is spaced on 640 acres, with one well allowed per quarter section, and wells to be located no closer than 660 feet to a quarter section line. Rule 4 of the special rules allows an interest owner to apply for a non-standard unit.
4. Applicant seeks to dedicate the S½ of Section 28 to its well to form a non-standard 320 acre gas spacing and proration unit in the Lusk-Morrow Gas Pool.
5. A non-standard unit covering the S½ of Section 28 will prevent waste and protect correlative rights.

WHEREFORE, applicant requests that, after notice and hearing, the Division enter its order approving the non-standard unit.
