This acreage is located in the Potash Area as defined by Division Order No. R-111-P.

This application has been set for hearing before a Division Examiner on November 4, 2004. The hearing will be held in Porter Hall in the Division's Santa Fe offices. You are not required to attend this hearing, but as an owner of an interest that may be affected by this application, you may appear and present testimony. Failure to appear at that time and become a party of record will preclude you from challenging the matter at a later date.
