Gentlemen:

Your letter of January 12, 1971, advises that Perry R. Bass, as operator of the Poker Lake unit, Eddy County, New Mcxico, has determined unit well No. 11 in the SWESN'S sec. 17, T. 25 S., R. 30 E., N.M.P.M., lease Las Cruces 064894-A, to be incapable of producing unitized substances in paying quantities from the Delaware.

Unit well No. Il was originally drilled to a total depth of 3,785 feet and abandougd in December 1959. Such well was recompleted on October 23, 1970, from perforations at 3,692 feet in the Delaware and tested on November 18 for an initial potential of 16 barrels of oil and 190 barrels of water per day. During November, the well produced 380 barrels of oil and 3,909 barrels of water and in December, it produced 295 barrels of oil and 3,330 barrels of water.

This office concurs with your determination that the well is not capable of producing unitized substances in paying quantities under existing conditions. Two surplus copies of the notice are attached.

Gentlemen:

In compliance with Section 10 of the Poker Lake Unit Agreement, dated July 16, 1952, Perry R. Bass, as Unit Operator, hereby submits for your approval a Plan of Development for 1972.

HISTORY OF PAST DEVELOPMENT

The past development on this Unit has consisted of four deep wells drilled to a depth of 13,500' or below. In addition to the four deep tests, 35 shallow wells have been drilled to develop Delaware or Lower Delaware production.

During the year 1971, approximately 30 miles of new seismic work was done in T-24-S, R-30-E, with the prospect of a deep Morrow test being drilled. Due to the fact that the undersigned did not control all of the acreage under this proposed location, the option by a third party to drill this well was not exercised.

FUTURE DEVELOPMENT

For 1972, a two-pronged plan of development is being proposed. The undersigned currently has its Engineering and Production Departments studying the feasibility and economics of re-entry and whipstock of the Richardson & Bass #1 Harrison in an attempt to extend Morrow production into this unit. This will require cutting a window in the casing and drilling a new sidetrack hole through the prospective pay zones. These same studies are being made on the Pan American #36 Poker Lake with the same objective

in mind.

At the present time, we have a third party interested in drilling a shallow well in the SW/4 NW/4 of Section 17, T-25-S, R-30-E. This well will be a Morrow test, and it is hopeful that negotiations will be completed early in 1972. We also have a farmout being made at the present time for a well to be drilled in the NE/4 NE/4 of Section 31, T-24-S, R-31-E, by Mr. E. P. Whealdon of Midland, Texas. The undersigned has agreed to contribute 480 acres around the location, while Superior has agreed to contribute 160 acres in Section 32, T-24-S, R-31-E, in support of this well. We are attempting to negotiate a reasonable trade with Pauley Petroleum, and it is anticipated that these negotiations will result in the drilling of this well early in 1972.

The undersigned has its Geological staff making detailed studies of the Atoka and Morrow sections of the Pennsylvanian formation at the present time. It is our feeling that this unit has excellent potential for gas reserves in these formations, and that the Morrow formation must be considered the primary objective. Morrow production can be found east, west and north of the unit, and the Morrow Sands are deposited in six major clastic cycles over an 800' vertical interval. This cycle appears to be deposited over the unit under blanket conditions. As yet, we do not have enough control to establish sufficient information to locate Morrow tests. However, additional information is being developed, such as the new seismic work, in the hope that some Morrow tests can be drilled.

ADDITIONAL DEVELOPMENT

This Plan of Development shall constitute the drilling obligations of the Unit Operator under the terms of the Poker Lake Unit Agreement ending December 31, 1972. Before this plan expires, a subsequent Plan of Development will be forwarded for your approval.

MODIFICATION

It is understood that this Plan of Development shall be effective as of January 1, 1972. If this plan meets with your approval, please indicate in the appropriate space and return one copy for our files.
