Well No. 38 was completed on Jonuary 5, 1970, for an initial pumping potential of 17 barrels of all and 15 barrels of water per day from Delaware performitions in the interval from 3,650 to 3,660 fact. During January, the well produced 243 barrels of oil and during Pebruary it produced 168 borrels of oil for a daily average of approximitely 9 and 6 barrels of oil per day, respectively. In compliance with Section 10 of the Poker Lake Unit Agreement, dated July 16, 1952, Perry R. Bass, as Unit Operator, hereby submits for your approval a Plan of Development for 1971.

HISTORY OF PAST DEVELOPMENT

The past development on this Unit has consisted of four deep wells drilled to a depth of 13,500' or below. In addition to the four deep tests, 35 shallow wells have been drilled to develop Delaware or Lower Delaware production.

Poker Lake Unit Well No. 38 was drilled during the years 1969-70. The location of this Unit well is in Section 19, Township 25 South, Range 30 East. The well was drilled to a total depth of 3,682' and plugged back to 3,661'. The well encountered the Delaware Sand from 3,650-60' and was completed in January, 1970 for 17 BO and 15 BWPD, plus a small amount of gas.

During the year 1970, the Perry R. Bass No. 1 Bass Continental Federal was reworked. This well is located in the NW/4 of Section 20, Township 25 South, Range 30 East. The well was perforated from 3,064-66' and 3,671-73' and was re-completed during the year to pump 30 BO and 80 BW.

In 1959, Alamo Corporation drilled Poker Lake Unit A-7 Well No. 11 and plugged and abandoned same as a dry hole. In August, 1970, Perry R. Bass re-entered said location. The location was leveled, and the 8-5/8" casing was dynamited to free the surface marker. Drilling was commenced August 31, 1970, 1971 Plan of Development Poker Lake Unit -/ Eddy County, New Mexico

and the well was subsequently re-drilled and fraced with a new Halliburton type frac, and the well was completed December 1, 1970 for 17 BO and 162 BW.

FUTURE DEVELOPMENT

We are still production testing the No. 11 Poker Lake well to see if the new frac treatment will adequately develop porosity and permeability in the Delaware section. Depending upon these tests, additional reservoirs can possibly be developed in these Delaware wells.

Our exploration program is continuing on this Unit, and we have just executed a seismic option agreement with American Trading Company to provide for at least 20 miles of new seismic work in the northern portion of this Unit, with the further commitment that if the seismic work proves out, a Devonian test will be drilled on the Unit.

ADDITIONAL DEVELOPMENT

This Plan of Development shall constitute the drilling obligations of the Unit Operator under the terms of the Poker Lake Unit Agreement ending December 31, 1971. Before this plan expires, a subsequent Plan of Development will be forwarded for your approval.

MODIFICATION

It is understood that this Plan of Development shall be effective as of January 1, 1971. If this Plan meets with your approval, please indicate in the appropriate space and return one copy for our files.
