This matter came on for hearing before the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division, RICHARD EZEANYIM, Hearing Examiner, on Thursday, August 25th, 2005, at the New Mexico Energy, Minerals and Natural Resources Department, 1220 South Saint Francis Drive, Room 102, Santa Fe, New Mexico, Steven T. Brenner, Certified Court Reporter No. 7 for the State of New Mexico.

WHEREUPON, the following proceedings were had at 1 8:29 a.m.: 2 EXAMINER EZEANYIM: Now, in continuing, for the 3 -- this is the way I wanted this case -- I mean, the docket 4 -- addressed today, and see anybody will have any objection 5 to that. 6 First of all, we're going to hear Case Number 7 13,541, followed by Case Number 13,519, and then Case 8 9 Number 13,547. I thought those were easily -- you know, we can get through them easily. 10 11 Then we go through Case Number 13,544, 13,545, 1.2 13,546. 13 There is -- There will be a contested case, combined Case Number 13,537 and 13,539. So we're going to 14 15 hear those at the last. Any objection to this arrangement? 16 17 MR. BRUCE: No, sir. 18 EXAMINER EZEANYIM: Okay, at this point, I call 19 Case Number 13,541, and this is the Application of Bass 20 Enterprises Company for compulsory pooling, Eddy County, New Mexico. 21 22 Call for appearances. 23 MS. MUNDS-DRY: Good morning, Mr. Hearing 24 Examiner, my name is Ocean Munds-Dry with the law firm of 25 Holland and Hart, representing Bass Enterprises Production

Company this morning.

EXAMINER EZEANYIM: Do you have any witnesses?

MS. MUNDS-DRY: No, no witnesses this morning.

EXAMINER EZEANYIM: Any other appearances?

Okay, with no other appearances, you can proceed at this point.

MS. MUNDS-DRY: Thank you, Mr. Hearing Examiner. Bass Enterprises Production Company this morning requests an order pooling the mineral interest owner -- there's one mineral interest owner in Section 32, Township 21 South, Range 28 East, in Eddy County, New Mexico -- under the Division's alternative procedure, Rule 1207.A.(1).(b). This procedure is available where you're unable to locate all owners of interest to be pooled and the application is unopposed by those located.

Mr. Hearing Examiner, all leased mineral owners in this proposed unit area have voluntarily agreed to pool their interests. However, Bass has been unable to locate one mineral interest owner. You'll note on the Application — on the exhibit, I believe, we listed two mineral interest owners. Since that time we have, in fact, located Mr. William Mann, and he has voluntarily agreed to commit his interest to the unit. That, however, leaves us with Mr. Dome, who has still — Bass has been unable to locate him.

With that, Mr. Examiner, we'd turn to Exhibit 1, and that is the affidavit of Ryan Dobbs, who's the landman for Bass discussing this project. He outlines the efforts to find Mr. Dome and also goes through the other necessary items under this alternative procedure, which we'll discuss in turn.

Mr. Hearing Examiner, if you'll turn to

Attachment A, that is a plat of the subject lands showing

the proposed spacing unit and well location. Bass proposes

to dedicate its Big Eddy Unit Well Number 149 to the

proposed spacing unit, which will be located at a standard

location 1980 from the north line and 660 from the east

line. And they plan to drill to a depth sufficient to

produce from the Morrow formation.

Mr. Hearing Examiner, if you'll now turn to
Attachment B, it shows you a list of the percentage of
working interest owners in the proposed spacing unit. As I
mentioned earlier, all interest owners have committed their
interest to the unit. The only person that we've been
unable to locate is Mr. Dome.

If you'll turn to Attachment C, it is a letter from Doug Ferguson, who is a landman who attempted to locate Mr. Dome on behalf of Bass Enterprises. He lists the efforts that he undertook to try to find Mr. Dome.

Similarly, Attachment D are previous attempts

also made by MYCO Industries, who, just to give you some background, Mr. Hearing Examiner, had originally proposed to be the operator of this well. Since that time Bass has now taken over and has proposed to be the operator. But this does give you the log of what MYCO also did to try to find Mr. Dome.

If you'll turn to Attachment E, it's a copy of the AFE which has also been sent to all of the working interest owners.

And finally Attachment F is my affidavit stating that proper notice was given to Mr. Dome, as well as an affidavit of publication notifying him of this hearing.

With that, Mr. Hearing Examiner, Bass therefore seeks an order pooling the interests of Mr. Dome. Bass proposes overhead charges about \$7000 per month while drilling and \$700 a month while producing.

Bass also requests that it be designated the operator of the well and the spacing unit. And as Mr. Dobbs testified to in this affidavit, approval of this Application will avoid drilling of unnecessary wells, will prevent waste, will protect correlative rights, and allow Bass and the other interest owners in the north half of Section 32 an opportunity to obtain their just and fair share underlying the subject lands.

14	MS. MUNDS-DRY: That's correct, Mr. Hearing
15	Examiner.
16	EXAMINER EZEANYIM: All the rest are committed to
17	the well, right?
18	MS. MUNDS-DRY: Yes.
19	EXAMINER EZEANYIM: The well is yet to be
20	drilled?
21	MS. MUNDS-DRY: That's correct.
22	EXAMINER EZEANYIM: And have you obtained any
23	APDs?
24	MS. MUNDS-DRY: Did they file an APD?
25	EXAMINER EZEANYIM: Yeah, have you obtained one?

1	MS. MUNDS-DRY: They have filed an APD, Mr.
2	Hearing Examiner. I do not have it with me. I can provide
3	it to you after the hearing if you'd like to see it.
4	EXAMINER EZEANYIM: But it has been approved,
5	right
6	MS. MUNDS-DRY: It has been approved, yes.
7	EXAMINER EZEANYIM: Any API number?
8	MS. MUNDS-DRY: The API number, yes, is 30-015-
9	33972.
10	EXAMINER EZEANYIM: Thank you. I have no further
11	questions.
12	MS. MUNDS-DRY: Thank you, Mr. Hearing Examiner.
13	EXAMINER EZEANYIM: At this point, Case Number
14	13,541 will be taken under advisement.
