PURPOSE: The purpose of this subpoena is to provide all of the information necessary for Yates Petroleum Corporation to be able to prepare its evidence and testimony for New Mexico Oil Conservation Division Case 13153.

PRODUCE THE FOLLOWING DOCUMENTS:

For the State "X" Well No. 1(API No. 30-025-01838), also known as the Limbaugh AYO State Well No. 1, located 1980 feet from the North and West lines of Section 12, Township 12 South, Range 34 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.

1. Chronological reports of all activity performed on the well including all daily drilling and completion reports;
2. Any and all documents and data concerning "workover" actually conducted, attempted or contemplated;
3. A detailed accounting of all expenses, and payments for any activity conducted on the subject well including copies of all invoices;
4. All openhole logs, including but not limited to wireline logs.

HEARING EXHIBITS:

1. Copies of all land exhibits and ownership data and exhibits to be used by you;
2. If not already included above, all data and documents utilized by you for support of all exhibits you will present at hearing.

INSTRUCTIONS

This Subpoena Duces Tecum seeks all information available to you or in your possession, custody or control from any source, wherever situated, including but not limited to information from any files, records, computers documents, employees, former employees, consultants, counsel and former counsel. It is directed to each person to whom such information is a matter of personal knowledge.

When used herein, "you" or "your" refers to the persons and entity to whom this Subpoena Duces Tecum is addressed to including all of his or its attorneys, officers, agents, consultants, employees, directors, representatives, officials, departments, divisions, subdivisions, subsidiaries, or predecessors in interest.

The term "document" as used herein means every writing and record of every type and description in the possession, your custody or control, whether prepared by you or otherwise, which is in your possession or control or known by you to exist, including but not limited to all drafts, papers, books, writings, records, letters, photographs, computer disks, tangible things, correspondence, communications, telegrams, cables, telex messages, memoranda, notes, notations, work papers, transcripts, minutes, reports and recordings of telephone or other conversations or of interviews, conferences, or meetings.
