## **APPLICATION**

NORTHSTAR OPERATING COMPANY ("NorthStar"), through its undersigned attorneys, hereby makes application for an order approving an unorthodox gas well location in the Devonian and Wolfcamp formations for its Fort Well No. 1 to be drilled in Unit G of Section 8, Township 15 South, Range 38 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico. In support of its application, NorthStar states:

- 1. NorthStar is the operator of the W/2 NE/4of Section 8 of Township 15 South, Range 38 East, NMPM, which, in a companion application, it seeks approval to unitize with the E/2 NW/4of the section.
- 2. NorthStar seeks an exception to Division Rule 104.B(1) to permit it to drill its Fort Well No. 1 to test all formations from the surface to the base of the Devonian formation at an unorthodox location 2100 feet from the North line and 2500 feet from the East line of said Section 15 as a wildcat well in the Wolfcamp and Devonian formations.
- 3. Approval of this application will be in the best interest of conservation, the prevention of waste and the protection of correlative rights.

WHEREFORE, NorthStar Operating Company requests that this application be set for hearing before an Examiner of the Oil Conservation Division on July 28, 2005 and after notice and hearing as required by law, the Division enter its order granting this application.
