

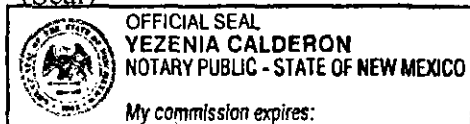

Davis Trust, or your heirs, devisees, or successors. Apache Corporation has filed an application with the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division seeking an order pooling all mineral interests from the surface to the base of the Drinkard formation underlying Lot 4 (the NW 1/4 NW 1/4) of Section 2, Township 20 South, Range 38 East, NMPM, to form a standard 39.73-acre oil spacing and proration unit for any and all formations or pools developed on 40-acre spacing within that vertical extent. The unit will be dedicated to the White Owl Well No. 2 to be drilled at an unorthodox oil well location 475 feet from the north line and 1075 feet from the west line of Section 2. Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling and completing the well and the allocation of the cost thereof, as well as actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of applicant as operator of the well, and a 200% charge for the risk involved in drilling and completing the well. As interest owners in adjoining Lot 3 of Section 2, you are also given notice of the above unorthodox oil well location. The application is scheduled to be heard at 8:15 a.m. on Thursday, May 16, 2013 at the Division's offices at 1220 South St. Francis Drive, Santa Fe, New Mexico 87505. As an interest owner in the well unit, or as an offsetting interest owner, you have the right to enter an appearance and participate in the case. Failure to appear will preclude you from contesting this matter at a later date. The attorney for applicant is James Bruce, P.O. Box 1056, Santa Fe, New Mexico 87504. The unit is located approximately 12 miles southwest of Nadine, New Mexico.
