STATEMENT OF THE CASE

APPLICANT

Applicant seeks an order approving a non-standard oil spacing and proration unit comprised of the S/2NE/4 of Section 17, Township 17 South, Range 37 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico, approving an unorthodox oil well location, and pooling all mineral interests from the surface to the top 200 feet of the Mississippian formation underlying the non-standard unit. Applicant proposes to drill the Sapient 17 Well No. 1 at an unorthodox surface location 1641 feet from the north line and 1225 feet from the east line, and a bottom hole location 1691 feet from

the north line and 1225 from the east line, of Section 17, to a depth sufficient to test the top 200 feet of the Mississippian formation, and will dedicate the S/2NE/4 of Section 17 to the well. Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling and completing the well and the allocation of the cost thereof, as well as actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of Nearburg Producing Company as operator of the well, and a 200% charge for the risk involved in drilling and completing the well.
