

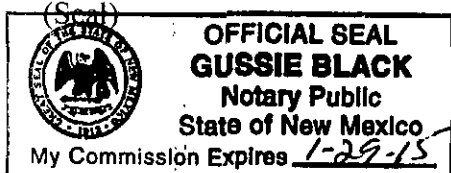

sory Pooling, Lea County, New Mexico. Applicant seeks  
an order consolidating the 40-acre spacing units within the  
E/2 W/2 of Section 11 and the NE/4 NW/4 of Section 14  
Township 17 South, Range 32 East, NMRM and designating  
the consolidated units as a 200-acre non-standard oil  
spacing and proration unit for a well location in the Yeso  
formation for Applicant's horizontal drilling project area. Ap-  
plicant further seeks the compulsory pooling of all interests  
in the Yeso formation underlying the E/2 W/2 of Section 11  
and the NE/4 NW/4 of Section 14 to be dedicated to its Pan  
Head Fee No. 4-H Well to be drilled horizontally from a sur-  
face location in the NE/4 NW/4 of Section 11 to a standard  
bottom hole location NE/4 NW/4 of Section 14 to a depth  
sufficient to test the Yeso formation. West Maljamar Yeso  
Pool (44500). Also to be considered will be the cost of drill-  
ing and completing said well and the allocation of the cost  
thereof as well as actual operating costs and charges for  
supervision, designation of COG Operating LLC as opera-  
tor and a charge for risk involved in drilling the well. The

southeast of Maljamar, New Mexico.
