- 2 EXAMINER EZEANYIM: Morning, gentlemen. We
- 3 are going to continue the docket we started yesterday,
- 4 Docket Number 23-13.
- 5 At this point, I call Case Number 15019,
- 6 application of Chi Operating, Inc. to amend Order Number
- 7 R-13262, Eddy County, New Mexico.
- 8 Call for appearances.
- 9 MR. BRUCE: Mr. Examiner, Jim Bruce of
- 10 Santa Fe representing the Applicant. And since this is
- 11 about as simple as they come, I'm just submitting it by
- 12 affidavit.
- 13 I'm handing you, as Exhibit 1, the
- 14 affidavit of John Qualls who is the landman for and an
- officer of Chi Operating, Inc. who operates the Benson
- 16 Delaware Unit in Eddy County, which contains 560 acres
- 17 of federal land.
- 18 EXAMINER EZEANYIM: Are there any other
- 19 appearances here?
- No other appearances. Go ahead.
- MR. BRUCE: Order R-13262 approved
- 22 unitization -- statutory unitization and enhanced
- 23 recovery project for the unit area in the Brushy Canyon
- 24 Formation. And as set forth in paragraph five of the
- 25 affidavit, the order approved, among other wells, six

- 1 wells for injection, and they were either going to be
- 2 new wells or wells converted from production.
- 3 Four of these wells have not been drilled,
- 4 and then two of them, the Benson Delaware Units 14 and
- 5 19 are still producing.
- Now, attached at the end is, for example --
- 7 in the interim, Chi has filed applications for two new
- 8 wells in the Benson Delaware Unit, the Unit Number 23
- 9 and Unit Number 24 wells. The only reason I attached
- 10 the final two pages of this is to show that these
- 11 APDs -- that this is the APD for the Number 23 well.
- 12 They've been pending for over 15 months at this point,
- and they couldn't get them approved. Chi didn't know
- 14 why. But when they finally got to meet with the BLM,
- 15 the BLM said they wanted the order amended to remove
- 16 from the order, as approved injection wells, the wells
- 17 identified in paragraph five of the affidavit
- 18 And so this application is merely to
- 19 request that those six wells be eliminated from the
- 20 order, although under Division rules, additional
- 21 injection wells can be approved administratively, which
- 22 Chi will do at that point. But the BLM wanted it done,
- 23 so that's what we did. That's why we're here today.
- 24 And when it came to notice, I really
- 25 couldn't think of anybody to notify other than the BLM,

- 1 and so we gave notice of this application to the BLM.
- 2 And that is submitted as my Affidavit of Notice, marked
- 3 Exhibit 2.
- With that, I'd move the admission of
- 5 Exhibits 1 and 2 and ask that the case be taken under
- 6 advisement
- 7 EXAMINER EZEANYIM: Exhibits 1 and 2 will
- 8 be admitted.
- 9 (Chi Exhibit Numbers 1 and 2 were offered
- and admitted into evidence.)
- 11 EXAMINER EZEANYIM: Do you have any
- 12 questions?
- EXAMINER BROOKS: No.
- 14 EXAMINER EZEANYIM: Any questions?
- 15 EXAMINER GOETZE: No questions.
- 16 EXAMINER EZEANYIM: Why did the BLM want
- 17 you to remove these wells as approved?
- MR. BRUCE: They never said. They just
- 19 said, You haven't either drilled the wells or converted
- 20 them from production to injection, so we want them
- 21 removed as approved injection wells. And that's all
- 22 they said. It's a condition to the granting of those
- 23 two new APDs, so that's why they're doing it.
- 24 EXAMINER EZEANYIM: I'm just curious why
- 25 that is.

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1	MR. BRUCE: They've never really explained.
2	MR. EZEANYIM: Are you not curious why they
3	want
4	MR. BRUCE: No, and neither is my client.
5	It took them a year just to get it to a meeting, get the
6	BLM to meet with them in the first place, so they're
7	doing whatever they can to get the APDs approved.
8	EXAMINER EZEANYIM: At this point, Case
9	Number 15019 will be taken under advisement.
