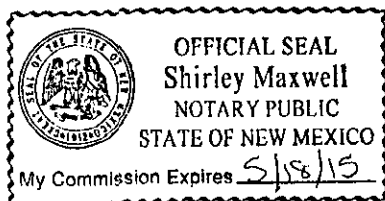

Patterson, Lucille Hayes, and Clifford Patterson, or their heirs, devisees, or successors: Mewbourne Oil Company has filed an application with the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division seeking an order approving a 160-acre non-standard oil spacing and proration unit (project area) in the Bone Spring formation comprised of the W/2E/2 of Section 8, Township 22 South, Range 25 East, NMPM. Applicant further seeks the pooling of all mineral interests in the Bone Spring formation underlying the W/2E/2 of Section 8 for all pools or formations developed on 40 acre spacing within that vertical extent. The unit is to be dedicated to the True Grit 8 B3B0 Fed. Com. Well No. 1H, a horizontal well with a surface location 402 feet from the north line and 1915 feet from the east line, and a terminus 330 feet from the south line and 1980 feet from the east line, of Section 8. Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling and completing the well and the allocation of the cost thereof, as well as actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of applicant as operator of the well, and a 200% charge for the risk involved in drilling and completing the well. The application is scheduled to be heard at 8:15 a.m. on Thursday, March 6, 2014 at the Division's offices at 1220 South St. Francis Drive, Santa Fe, New Mexico 87505. As an interest owner in the well unit you have the right to enter an appearance and participate in the case. Failure to appear will preclude you from contesting this matter at a later date. The attorney for applicant is James Bruce, P.O. Box 1056, Santa Fe, New Mexico 87504. The unit is located approximately 11 miles west of Carlsbad, New Mexico.
