Dear Sirs:

This second directive is to notify you that these wells are still in violation of Rule 201.

On 3 December, 2001 a letter was sent notifying you on the violation of Rule 201 and 116. An inspection of the wells and battery on 26 March, 2002 found no action has been taken.

These wells must be brought into compliance on or before 31 March, 2002.

To bring the wells into compliance you have 3 options:

1. Put the wells into production.
2. T.A. the wells.
3. P. A. the wells.

In the event that a satisfactory response is not received to this letter of direction by 15 April, 2002, further enforcement will occur. Such enforcement may include this office applying to the Division for an order summoning you to a hearing before a Division Examiner in Santa Fe to show cause why you should not be ordered to permanently plug and abandon this well. Such a hearing may result in imposition of **CIVIL PENALTIES** for your violation of OCD rules.


The State of New Mexico is in the process at this time of reviewing leases to determine the number of out of service wells.

Rule 201 A. states " The operator of any well drilled for oil, gas or injection, for seismic, core or any other exploration, or for a service well, whether cased or uncased, shall be responsible for the plugging thereof.

Rule 201 B. A well shall be either properly plugged abandoned or temporarily abandoned in accordance with these rules within (90) days after (1) a 60 day period following suspension of drilling. (2) A determination that the well is no longer usable for beneficial purposes. (3) A period of 1 year in which a well has been continuously inactive.

House Bill 65 has been passed by the legislature and provides some tax incentives for wells put back in production. However, if there are no plans to put these wells back in service then they will need to be plugged or properly temporarily abandoned.
