## MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION HELD ON MAY 22, 2014

The Oil Conservation Commission met at 9 o'clock a.m. on May 22, 2014, in Porter Hall, Wendell Chino Building, 1220 S. St. Francis Drive, Santa Fe, New Mexico.

Bill Brancard served as the Commission counsel.

The meeting was called to order by Chair Bailey. After a motion by Commissioner Warnell and a second to the motion by Commissioner Balch, the Commission unanimously agreed to approve and adopt the minutes of the March 13, 2014 Commission meeting.

Case 15103, the application of Occidental Permian Ltd. to amend Order R-6199-B to expand the North Hobbs Grayburg-San Andres Unit Phase I Tertiary Recovery Project, to modify certain operating requirements, and to certify this expansion for the recovered oil tax rate pursuant to the New Mexico Enhanced Oil Recovery Act, Lea County, New Mexico, was called for final action.

Counsel Brancard advised the Commission that, at the March 13, 2014 hearing of this case, the applicant was directed to provide additional notice. Michael Feldewert made an appearance for Occidental Permian Ltd. and presented an additional exhibit, No. 16, showing a corrected notice of publication directed to parties who were unable to be located. The exhibit was admitted. Counsel Brancard stated that no comments have been received by the Commission regarding this project. He explained the background of the hearing and the draft order issued in this case. After a motion by Commissioner Balch and a second to the motion by Commissioner Warnell, the Commission unanimously agreed to adopt the order and Order No. R-6199-F was signed by all Commissioners.

Case 15127, the application of DCP Midstream, LP for authorization to inject acid gas into the Artesia AGI #2 Well, Section 7, Township 18 South, Range 28 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico, was called and continued to the Commission meeting scheduled for June 19, 2014.

After a motion by Commissioner Balch and a second to the motion by Commissioner Warnell, the Commission unanimously agreed to adjourn the meeting at 9:10 a.m.
