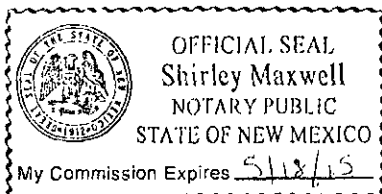

To: Partnership Properties Co., or your successors or assigns. Cimarex Energy Co. of Colorado has filed an application with the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division seeking an order approving a 480-acre non-standard gas spacing and proration unit (project area) in the Wolfcamp formation comprised of the SE/4 of Section 34, Township 25 South, Range 26 East, NMPM and the E/2 of Section 33, Township 26 South, Range 26 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico. Applicant further seeks the pooling of all mineral interests in the Wolfcamp formation underlying the non-standard unit (project area) for any pools or formations developed on 320-acre spacing within that vertical extent. The unit is to be dedicated to the Hayduke 34, Fed. Com. Well No. 3, a horizontal well with a surface location in the NE/4SE/4 of Section 34 and a terminus in the SE/4SE/4 of Section 33. Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling and completing the well and the allocation of the cost thereof, actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of applicant as operator of the well and a 200% charge for the risk involved in drilling and completing the well. The application is scheduled to be heard at 8:15 a.m. on Thursday, May 29, 2014 at the Division's offices at 1220 South St. Francis Drive, Santa Fe, New Mexico 87505. As an interest owner in the well unit, you have the right to enter an appearance and
