Chevron seeks an order (1) creating a 160-acre spacing and proration unit comprised of the W/2 E/2 of Section 14, Township 24 South, Range 34 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico; and (2) pooling all mineral interests in the Bone Spring formation underlying this acreage. This non-standard spacing and proration unit will be the project area for the proposed **Gramma Ridge 14-24-34 1H Well,** which will be horizontally drilled from a surface location in the NW/4 NE/4 (Unit B) to a standard bottom hole location in SW/4 SE/4 (Unit O) of Section

14. The completed interval for this well will remain within the 330-foot standard offset required by Division rules.
