

CASE 15149: Application of COG Operating, LLC for a non-standard spacing and proration unit and compulsory pooling, Eddy County, New Mexico. Applicant in the above styled cause seeks an order (1) creating a non-standard, 160-acre spacing and proration unit comprised of the W/2E/2 of Section 8, Township 19 South, Range 26 East, NMPM, Eddy County, and (2) pooling all mineral interests in the Yeso formation underlying this acreage. Said non-standard unit is to be dedicated to applicant's proposed Bradley 8. Fee 3H Well, which will be horizontally drilled from a surface location in the SW/4SE/4 (Unit O) to a standard bottom hole location in the NW/4NE/4 (Unit B) of Section 8. The completed interval for this well will commence in the SW/4SE/4 (Unit O) of Section 8 and remain within the 330-foot standard offset required by the rules. Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling and completing said well and the allocation of the cost thereof as well as actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of COG Operating, LLC as operator of the well and a 200% charge for risk involved in drilling said well. Said area is located approximately 1 mile Southwest of Frontier Post, New Mexico.
