COG Operating LLC seeks an order (1) creating a 160-acre spacing and proration unit comprised of the W/2W/2 of Section 23, Township 18 South, Range 33 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico; and (2) pooling all mineral interests in the Bone Spring formation (Corbin; Bone Spring South Pool) underlying this acreage. This proposed non-standard spacing and proration unit will be the project area for the proposed Scooter Federal Com 1H Well, which will be horizontally drilled from a surface location 190 feet from the North line and 460 feet from the West line (Unit D) to a bottom hole location 330 feet from the South line and 380 feet
