

The unit will be dedicated to the Pinot Well Nos. 3 and 6, to be drilled at an orthodox oil well location in the SE/4 NW/4 of Section 2. Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling and completing the well and the allocation of the cost thereof, as well as actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of applicant as operator of the well, and a 200% charge for the risk involved in drilling and completing the well. The application is scheduled to be heard at 8:15 a.m. on Thursday, October 30, 2014 at the Division's offices at 1220 South St. Francis Drive, Santa Fe, New Mexico 87505.
