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

APPLICATION

MRC Permian Company applies for an order (i) approving a 160 acre non-standard oil spacing and proration unit in the Bone Spring formation comprised of the E $\frac{1}{2}$ E $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 16, Township 19 South, Range 34 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico, and (ii) pooling all mineral interests in the Bone Spring formation underlying the non-standard unit, and in support thereof, states:

1. Applicant is an interest owner in the E $\frac{1}{2}$ E $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 16, and has the right to drill a well thereon.
2. Applicant proposes to drill the Cimarron State 16-19S-34E RN Well No. 134H to a depth sufficient to test the Bone Spring formation (Quail Ridge Bone Spring Pool). Applicant seeks to dedicate the E $\frac{1}{2}$ E $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 16 to the well to form a non-standard 160 acre oil spacing and proration unit (project area) for any formations and/or pools developed on 40 acre spacing within that vertical extent. The well is a horizontal well with a surface location in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, and a terminus in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, of Section 16.
3. Applicant has in good faith sought to obtain the voluntary joinder of all other mineral interest owners in the E $\frac{1}{2}$ E $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 16 for the purposes set forth herein.
4. Although applicant attempted to obtain voluntary agreements from all mineral interest owners to participate in the drilling of the wells or to otherwise commit their interests to the wells, certain interest owners have failed or refused to join in dedicating their interests.


Therefore, applicant seeks an order pooling all mineral interest owners in the E½E½ of Section 16, pursuant to NMSA 1978 §§70-2-17, 18.

5. Approval of the non-standard unit and the pooling of all mineral interests underlying the E½E½ of Section 16 will prevent the drilling of unnecessary wells, prevent waste, and protect correlative rights.

WHEREFORE, applicant requests that, after notice and hearing, the Division enter its order:

- A. Approving a non-standard oil spacing and proration unit (project area) in the Bone Spring formation in the E½E½ of Section 16;
- B. Pooling all mineral interests in the Bone Spring formation underlying the E½E½ of Section 16;
- C. Designating Matador Production Company as operator of the well;
- D. Considering the cost of drilling and completing the well, and allocating the costs among the well's working interest owners;
- E. Approving actual operating charges and costs charged for supervision, together with a provision adjusting the rates pursuant to the COPAS accounting procedure; and
- F. Setting a 200% charge for the risk involved in drilling and completing the well in the event a working interest owner elects not to participate in the well.

PROPOSED ADVERTISEMENT

Case No. 15243 :

Application of MRC Permian Company for approval of a non-standard oil spacing and proration unit and compulsory pooling, Lea County, New Mexico. Applicant seeks an order approving a 160-acre non-standard oil spacing and proration unit (project area) in the Bone Spring formation comprised of the E/2E/2 of Section 16, Township 19 South, Range 34 East, NMPM. Applicant further seeks the pooling of all mineral interests in the Bone Spring formation underlying the non-standard spacing and proration unit (project area) for all pools or formations developed on 40 acre spacing within that vertical extent. The unit is to be dedicated to the Cimarron State 16-19S-34E RN Well No. 134H, a horizontal well with a surface location in the NE/4NE/4, and a terminus in the SE/4SE/4, of Section 16. Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling and completing the well and the allocation of the cost thereof, as well as actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of Matador Production Company as operator of the well, and a 200% charge for the risk involved in drilling and completing the well. The unit is located approximately 17 miles west-northwest of Monument, New Mexico.

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
