- (1) Ordering Paragraph (5) of Order No. R-13932 is hereby amended, *nunc pro tunc*, effective as of November 13, 2014, to read:
 - (5) Should the first proposed well not be drilled to completion, or be abandoned, within 120 days after commencement thereof, then Ordering Paragraph (1) shall be of no further effect unless the Operator appears before the Division Director and obtains an extension of the time for completion of such well for good cause shown by satisfactory evidence.

- (2) In all other respects Order No. R-13932 shall remain in full force and effect as originally written.
- (3) Jurisdiction of this case is retained for the entry of such further orders as the Division may deem necessary.
