Submitted as Exhibit A is an affidavit of notice. The party being pooled was Ensign Oil Company of Midland, Texas. Previously, the certified notice had been refused or never picked up by Ensign Oil, but this time around they did accept service of the certified mail. And so I submit that to show that notice has been given. I have published notice, but since the personal service was accepted I'm
