Commission Order R-13506-D, Finding AA:

"While Applicants urge that a multi-well fluid management pit is most akin to a temporary pit, the Commission finds that the size and life span of a multi-well fluid management pit, which could be up to 5 years, and the fact that it is fluid bearing for that period of time, it is more prudent to treat the multi-well fluid management pit more like a permanent pit, with respect to siting, construction, operation and closure. The Commission finds that there is sufficient environmental and economic justification for permitting multi-well fluid management pits under the Pit Rule, and that doing so under, among other things, the siting, construction, inspection, operation and closure requirements of the Pit Rule that is Attachment A provides reasonable protection of fresh water, and protects public health and the environment."
