Commission Order Order R-13506-D, Finding M:

"A majority of the Commission finds that testing for the constituents set forth in Table I and Table II in Section 19.15.17.13 of Attachment A, provides reasonable protection of fresh water, and protects public health and the environment."

Commission Order Order R-13506-D, Finding P:

"The benzene level that is reflected in Tables I and II, is lower than the levels recommended by the American Petroleum Institute, and GRO and DRO, while they could affect the odor and taste of water, are not a matter of concern with respect to toxicity. The other compounds in TPH, the oil range organics and asphaltenes, are made up of large molecules and are not sufficiently mobile to pose a concern for human health or fresh water."
