## APPLICATION OF APACHE CORPORATION FOR APPROVAL OF A NON-STANDARD GAS SPACING AND PRORATION UNIT, LEA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO.

## **APPLICATION**

Apache Corporation applies for an order approving a non-standard 80 acre gas spacing and proration unit in the North Eunice-San Andres Gas Pool comprised of the E/2NE/4 of Section 17, Township 21 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, and in support thereof, states:

1. Applicant is a working interest owner in the E/2NE/4 of Section 17.

2. Apache operates the Lockhart A-17 Well No. 4 (aka the West Blinebry Drinkard Unit Well No. 67), located 660 feet from the north and east lines of Section 17, which is a water source well for the waterflood unit. This well had been producing large amounts of water, and minimal gas, from the San Andres formation. Recently, Applicant re-worked the well to shut-off the lower set of San Andres perforations due to issues with barium scale. The workover caused gas production from the well to increase significantly.

3. To produce the gas, Apache must re-designate this well from water source well to a gas well in the North Eunice-San Andres Gas Pool, although the well will remain a water source well for the unit. Spacing in the pool is 160 acres.

4. The Lockhart A-17 lease is a federal lease (containing a sliding scale royalty) which covers, among other lands, the E/2NE/4 Section 17. Thus, forming the proposed non-standard unit will not require an adjustment of equities in the well. The unit will be dedicated to the Lockhart A-17 Well No. 4:

5. Time is of the essence in approving the non-standard unit because the well provides approximately one-half of the water needed for unit operations.

6. Approval of this application will prevent waste, protect correlative rights, and conserve natural resources.

WHEREFORE, applicant requests that, after hearing, the Division enter its order approving the relief requested herein.
