Devon Energy Production Company, L.P. applies for an order instituting special rules and regulations for the West Jennings-Bone Spring Pool (the "Pool"), and in support thereof, states:

1. Applicant is an operator in the Pool.
2. The Pool currently includes the following acreage in Eddy County, New Mexico:

Township 26 South, Range 31 East, N.M.P.M.

Section 10: All

Section 11: All

In addition, the Division's Hobbs Office proposes to expand the Pool to include the following acreage:

Township 25 South, Range 31 East, N.M.P.M.

Section 35: W/2

Township 26 South, Range 31 East, N.M.P.M.

Section 1: NW/4

Section 2: All

Section 4: W/2

Section 8: E/2

Section 9: All

Section 12: All

Section 14: NW/4

3. The Pool is governed by the Division's statewide rules for oil pools, with 40 acre well units and wells to be located no closer than 330 feet to a quarter-quarter section line.

4. The Pool has a depth bracket allowable of 230 barrels of oil per day for a standard 40 acre oil spacing and proration unit. **NMAC 19.15.20.12.**

5. Applicant intends to drill and complete horizontal wells in the Pool, or within one mile thereof, including well units which will contain two or three Bone Spring wells in a single well unit. Applicant believes that such well units will produce in excess of the current allowable.

6. Applicant requests that special rules and regulations for the Pool be established for the Pool, providing for:


(a) a special depth bracket allowable of 690 barrels of oil per day for a standard 40 acre oil well unit; and

(b) all other rules to be in conformance with statewide rules.

7. The granting of this application is in the interests of conservation, the prevention of waste, and the protection of correlative rights.

WHEREFORE, applicant requests that, after notice and hearing, the Division grant the relief requested above.
