

APPLICATION

Kaiser-Francis Oil Company applies for an order abolishing Rules 2-6 of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Bell Lake-Bone Spring Pool, Lea County, New Mexico, and in support thereof, states:

1. The Bell Lake-Bone Spring Pool (the "Pool") was created by Division Order R-738, and currently includes the following acreage:

Township 23 South, Range 33 East, N.M.P.M.

Section 36: All

Township 23 South, Range 34 East, N.M.P.M.

Section 31: Lots 1-4, E/2, and E/2W/2 (All)

Section 32: All

Township 24 South, Range 33 East, N.M.P.M.

Section 1: Lots 1-4, S/2N2, and S/2 (All)

Section 12: All

Township 24 South, Range 34 East, N.M.P.M.

Section 5: Lots 1-4, S/2N2, and S/2 (All)

Section 6: Lots 1-7, S/2NE/4, SE/4NW/4, E/2SW/4, and SE/4 (All)

Section 7: Lots 1-4, E/2, and E/2W/2 (All)

Section 8: All

2. Division Order R-4539, as amended, established Special Rules and Regulations for the Pool, which include:

Rule 2: Standard 160 acre well units.

- Rule 3: Non-standard well units of less than 160 acres.
- Rule 4: Wells to be located no closer than 660 feet to a quarter section line, nor closer than 330 feet to a quarter-quarter section line.
- Rule 5: Unorthodox well locations under certain circumstances.
- Rule 6: A depth bracket allowable of 470 barrels of oil per day.
- Rule 7: A limiting gas:oil ratio of 5000 cubic feet of gas per barrel of oil produced.

3. Applicant is an operator in the Pool.


4. Applicant requests that Rules 2-6 of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Pool be abolished, and that well spacing, well locations, and the depth bracket allowable be governed in the future by the Division's statewide rules. Applicant requests that Rule 7 remain in effect.

5. **Applicant requests that all existing 160 acre well units or approved non-standard well units in the Pool be grandfathered in, unless an operator desires to change the spacing for a well unit.**

6. Approval of this application will prevent waste and protect correlative rights.

WHEREFORE, applicant requests that, after notice and hearing, the Division enter its order granting the relief requested above.

Division Order R-4539, as amended, established Special Rules and Regulations for the Bell Lake-Bone Spring Pool, providing in Rules 2-6 for 160 acre spacing, wells to be located no closer than 660 feet to a quarter section line, and a depth bracket allowable of 470 barrels of oil per day. Applicant requests that Rules 2-6 of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Bell Lake-Bone Spring Pool be abolished, so that well spacing, well locations, and the depth bracket allowable in the Pool will be governed by the Division's statewide rules, with the exception that existing 160 acre well units be grandfathered in. The Bell Lake-Bone Spring Pool is centered approximately 20-1/2 miles west-northwest of Jal, New Mexico.

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
