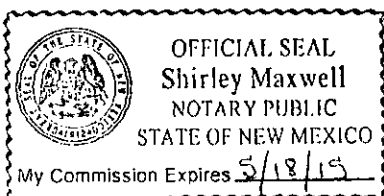

seeking an order pool-  
ing all mineral inter-  
ests in the Bone  
Spring formation un-  
derlying the W/2W/2  
of Section 27 and the  
W/2W/2 of Section  
22, Township 26  
South, Range 27, East  
NMPM. Applicant fur-  
ther seeks the pooling  
of all mineral interests  
in the Bone Spring for-  
mation underlying the  
non-standard unit for  
all pools or formations  
developed on 40 acre  
spacing within that  
vertical extent. The  
unit is to be dedicated  
to the Owl Draw  
27/22 B2MD Fed.  
Com. Well No. 1H, a  
horizontal well with a  
surface location 170  
feet from the south  
line and 330 feet from
